7 p.m. at Test Secretary's Home. Interested parties may attend.

Confirmations and directions will be sent to the e-mail address given on the entry form; otherwise confirmations and directions will be sent to the address given on the entry form. Chapter 1, Section 13, of the Tracking Regulations: "Specialty clubs may, through the use of a lottery draw allow other breeds to enter their specialty using the following procedure: Draw (1) Specialty breed without a title; Draw (2) Specialty breed with a title; Draw (3) Other breeds without a title; Draw (4) Other breeds with a title." Immediately after the draw, the Secretary will notify owners of the results of the draw by e-mail or telephone.

Chapter 1, Section 13a of the Tracking regulations: Should one test or the other not fill, then tracks will be exchanged at the rate of 1 TDX=2 TD.

Chapter 2, Section 2, of the Tracking Regulations: "Certification. A written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD test. This statement must be dated within one year of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test."

Chapter 3, Section 1, of the Tracking Regulations: "Eligibility. This test will be for dogs not less than six (6) months of age that are eligible for entry and that meet the requirements of the following Section 2. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the titles TD, TDX or VST. Dogs not holding a Tracking Dog title will be given priority for entry in the test by the tracking test secretary."

Bitches in season may participate in accordance with Chapter 2,
Section 8, of the Tracking Regulations.

All exhibitors must check in with the test secretary prior to 8:00 AM. Should a drawn entry be absent the day of the test, the vacancy will be filled by the next present alternate.

Directions to Draw Site and Test Site

From the Travelodge: Go north on Baltimore Street. At the next roundabout, take the second exit onto Carlisle Street. Carlisle Street becomes Biglerville Road/PA 34. Take a slight right onto Table Rock Road. Go about 2 miles and the test site will be on your right. Look for flags.

From Harrisburg: Take US 15 South. Take the PA394/US 15 Business exit toward Huntersville. Turn right onto Shrivvers Corner Road (PA 394). Go about 1.5 miles and turn left onto Goldenville Road. Go about a mile and turn left onto Table Rock Road. Go a little more than a mile and the test site will be on your left. Look for flags.

From Host Hotel approx 1 hr 20 min): Head west on US -30 W/Lincoln Hwy E toward Stanley K Tanger Dr. Continue to follow US -30 W 35.5 mi. Merge onto US -30 W/W Market St via the ramp to Gettysburg. Continue to follow US -30 W 3.2 mi. Turn right at N Biesecker Rd/State Route 3061 1.0 mi. Turn left at PA-234 W/E Berlin Rd. Continue to follow PA-234 W 19.5 mi. Turn left at Old Carlisle Rd 1.6 mi. Continue onto PA-394 E/Table Rock Rd. Continue to follow Table Rock Rd and Destination will be on the left.

I (WE) ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE Rules Applying to Dog Shows and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the Obedience Regulations, have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. [2] The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

[3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

[4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
